Notification of Suspension of Six (6) Listed Companies

Dealing members are hereby notified that pursuant to Rule 3.1, Rules for Filing of Accounts and Treatment of Default Filing, Rulebook of The Exchange (Issuers' Rules) ("Default Filing Rules"), which provides that; *"If an Issuer fails to file the relevant accounts by the expiration of the Cure Period, The Exchange will:*

(a) Send to the Issuer a "Second Filing Deficiency Notification" within two (2) business days after the end of the Cure Period;

(b) Suspend trading in the Issuer's securities; and

(c) Notify the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and the Market within twenty- four (24) hours of the suspension", the shares of the six (6) under listed companies have been suspended from trading via the facilities of The Exchange, effective today, 1 November 2018.
